A FATHER JOHN'S SUCCESS STORY

There are few things I enjoy more than sharing the wonderful story of how I came to adopt my beloved cat, Duncan, from Father John's Animal House. In 2004, I had moved into my first house and I couldn't wait to adopt a pet to share my home. The problem was that I was afraid to go to an animal shelter because I knew it would break my heart to have to choose only one animal and leave the rest behind. How would I ever make that choice? Along came fate to the rescue.

One day a coworker asked me if I would buy a chocolate Easter rabbit to help raise money for Father John's where her daughter was a volunteer. While I bought the chocolate, I told her how much I wanted to adopt a cat and she immediately said "the hair on the back of my neck just stood up". I asked her why and she said her daughter loved taking care of a cat named Duncan who had been at Father John's for two years waiting for adoption, and my coworker had a feeling Duncan might be the perfect pet for me. She explained that Duncan was having a hard time finding a home because he had herpes in his right eye and required special care.

Two days later, she and I went to Father John's so I could meet Duncan. The instant I saw him I knew I was meant to be his mother and to give him the best possible life I could offer. Two years in a cage and a sore

eye didn't diminish his remarkable spirit in the least and it took us about two seconds to bond. He came home with me two days later.

After being treated by a veterinary ophthalmologist, his eye condition is now largely controlled with eye drops, and if he could talk I am confident he would say he loves his home. I could not love him more.
